


“Libraries Rock!” Board Book Recommendations




[Barnyard Boogie! by Tim McCanna](#)


[My Rainbow Surprise by Amy Sklansky](#)


[Dinosaur Discovery by Salina Yoon](#)

Introduces dinosaurs, providing facts about such prehistoric beasts as Triceratops, Stegosaurus, and Parasaurolophus.




[Vroom, Vroom, Trucks! by Karen Katz](#)

Little ones can lift the flaps at the construction site to reveal bulldozers, dump trucks, and more things that build!




[Where is Frog? by Max Velthuis](#)

Illustrations introduce shapes to young readers, including a rectangle, circle, triangle, and diamond, in a book with die-cut pages.




[Find Spot at the Museum by Eric Hill](#)

When Spot goes missing during a visit to the natural history museum, his Mother and Tom search high and low and in unexpected places to find him.




[Boats Go by Steve Light](#)
